Local Orlando, FL Web 2.0 start-up looking for up to three web "developers" to complete an already started adaptation and re-configuration of a pre-purchased, customizable, scaleable, full-featured database application.

Must be competent in CSS and/or PHP / MySQL, as project consists of developing an informational web-community that is database-driven with the ability to service potentially hundreds of thousands of users.

Project is well underway including purchased and implemented software application, project management system, master programming documentation, site map, graphic and interface assets, etc.

We are looking for a commitment that would ideally be full time, but part-time candidates working together could work well also, possibly people who have worked well together in the past. The most important thing is a good fit. Ideally the developer(s) would remain with the company on a permanent-basis and may work into a lead role.

Compensation may be negotiable, but should be approached first at an intern-level, as there is a limited budget until Beta is reached, which will enable the raising of additional capital, allowing an increase compensation. Candidates may consider an arrangement to defer partial compensation or accept stock in the company as partial compensation. The catch is that we need to have a working model of the site in place in order to effectively raise more investment capital.

This is to be a temp-to-perm opportunity, on an independent contractor-base, so we prefer ambitious students, looking to get a jump-start on their career(s). We welcome both students and graduates. Once the contract is fulfilled successfully, candidate(s) would have an inside-track to a full-time position for continued web development, maintenance, and support.
